About Chest X-ray	Both men and women are allowed to wear only a plain T-shirt on the upper body during the X-ray in order to prevent images from appearing on the chest X-ray. Please come in clothes that are easy to take off and put on. Notes: T-shirts with no prints, embellishments, or pockets are acceptable as long as they are plain, even if they are not white. Women can wear a sports bra without metal fittings or plastic hooks under a plain T-shirt, but not a bra top or a T-shirt with cups. Students who are enrolled in practical teaching and nursing care experience, and students who wish to study abroad must undergo a chest X-ray examination. In addition, even for students who are not eligible for chest X-ray examinations, students who are planning to look for a job, have scholarships, submit documents to part-time jobs, etc., can take an X-ray if they wish. Please apply at the reception on the day.		
Others	•Please bring your student ID card (not required for newly-enrolled students) and strictly adhere to the designated reception time. •In order to use the gymnasium, please bring a bag to put your shoes in, and bring your indoor shoes such as athletic shoes or slippers if you like. •Health certificate cannot be issued for students who do not take the health checkup (including online questionnaire). •No announcement or reminder will be sent to the students who miss the health checkup dates. •If you visit an external medical institution and take health checkup at your own expense, please submit the results. Please be sure to answer the online medical questionnaire even if you have a medical examination outside the university.
